



Call for Expression of Interest

Proposals for the Design and Operation of a Packaging Recovery Certification Service

CLARIFICATIONS

Q1. The document refers to “ re-processors ”. Does this include waste brokers or is the term limited to recovered waste management facilities (e.g. Wasteserv) ?

The term "re-processor" deals specifically with a waste management facility that concludes a recovery process by means of completing the whole cycle of the recycling process and converts a 'waste' to a 'product'. In general, it does not specifically involve a waste broker. On the other hand, the term waste broker refers to any undertaking arranging the recovery or disposal of waste on behalf of others, including such brokers who do not take physical possession of the waste. However, in some part of the terms of reference, there is reference to both re-processors and exporters (which may include waste brokers).

Q2. The document refers to “ exporters of packaging waste ” . Does the term include waste brokers?

Yes, exporters of packaging waste may also include the waste brokers, since they carry out any undertaking arranging the recovery or disposal of waste on behalf of others, including such brokers who do not take physical possession of the waste.

Q3 . Could you kindly confirm to us :

- **the number of registered producers of packaging waste ; and**

1,654 producers registered in 2007 declaring data for 2006, 1,325 producers in 2008 declaring data for 2007, and 918 producers in 2009 declaring data for 2008.

- **the number of registered re-processors of packaging waste in terms of your answer to question 1 above ; and**

In this regards, the list of local facilities that are able to accept packaging waste are the following:

1. Ghallis landfill
2. Temporary Storage Facility - Marsa
